Membership Information

Psychology Club and Psi Chi are two different organizations that have chosen to come together for the mutual benefit of each other. Both clubs exist primarily for psychology majors at the University of Florida, although membership is open to all students. Psi Chi is the honors club for Psychology majors at the University of Florida and is affiliated with the national organization Psi Chi. Membership requirements are explained fully in the Member Handbook, but some important details are as follows:



You must pay dues: \$25.00 for each semester or \$40.00 for both semesters

a one-time payment of \$35.00 if joining Psi Chi (in addition to regular dues)

Basic Membership requires only the paying of dues.

Active Membership requires, in addition to dues, participation in at least one of each of the following per semester: a fundraising event, a philanthropy event, and a social event.

Exemplary Membership requires active membership plus participation in most Club activities and/or other service such as volunteering for committee work and special projects.

Psi Chi Membership requires a 3.5 GPA in psychology and a 3.2 overall GPA. Three semesters of college; one semester at UF. Three psychology classes. Additional requirements can be found in the Member Handbook or online at <http://www.psichi.org/about/becomember.asp>.
