**Eligibility:** Students in good standing who have completed at least semester and have earned a 2.5 GPA on 4.0 scale.

### **FEEES DUE UPON APPLICATION:**

A \$250 nonrefundable deposit toward the total cost of the program is required at the time of application. The remaining fees are due **no later** than 30 days prior to departure.

Students receiving financial aid may defer payment until their financial aid disperses.

### ***Not Included in the program fees:***

round-trip airfare, meals, course reading packet, additional personal travel and personal expenses.

**2012 Graduate Program Fee: \$5,398**

**Fee includes:** Tuition for 6 or 7 credits, housing, resident permit, museum pass, excursions to Venice and Rome, arrival and farewell party, international health insurance and medical emergency assistance.

## UF in Florence

The UF in Florence program has been developed in partnership with the Florence University of the Arts (FUA) and the University of South Florida (USF). Faculty from all three institutions will conduct the classes. Courses in credits in Psychology, Italian culture, digital photography and language are offered.

## Housing

Students will stay in furnished apartments. Each apartment has one, two or four bedrooms and students will share a bedroom. Apartments include kitchens complete with cooking supplies, plates, glasses, and utensils. **Students must provide one twin-sized sheet set and a towel.**

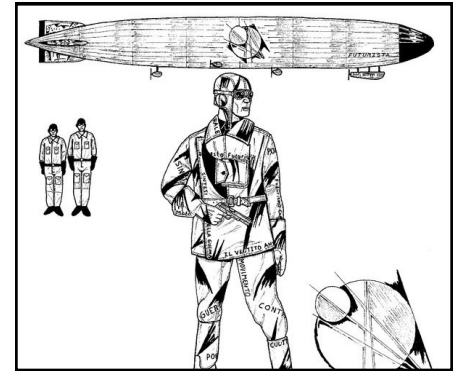
## Academic Credits

With prior approval, credits taken can satisfy major, minor, and university requirements. UF GPA credit will be granted for courses taken with UF faculty. Transfer credit will be issued for classes taught by FUA and USF instructors.
